The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 5:00 p.m. on the 15th day of May 2023. The following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

Ken Sockwell, Council President, presided at the meeting. Mayor Mike Lockhart was also present. Brittney Walker, Finance Officer, and Kate Isbell, Administrative Assistant/Marketing, were present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Steve Trash discussed with the Mayor and Council the opportunity to fund a child's experience at Magic Camp. He presented a demonstration in order to better explain the need for Social Emotional Learning (SEL), which Magic Camp was explained to help with.

Mayor Lockhart discussed with the Council the comprehensive plan and extending the Moratorium for 180 days.

Mayor Lockhart presented the semi-annual financial reports and explained to the Council that the revenues exceeded the expenses. Mostly all of the large expenses have been expensed.

Brittney Walker, Finance Officer, presented two potential Certificate of Deposits. The first CD had a rate of 4.9% for 6 months at 1,000,000. The second CD had a rate of 4.9% for 12 months at 1,000,000.

The council reviewed agenda items.

The meeting was called to order by Ken Sockwell, Council President. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:






COUNCIL MEMBER – PLACE ONE




COUNCIL MEMBER – PLACE TWO



COUNCIL MEMBER – PLACE THREE




COUNCIL MEMBER – PLACE FOUR


