## MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD May 15, 2017

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:00 p.m. on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2017 being the scheduled time and approved place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by Allen Noles, President of the Council. The invocation was given by Ricky Williams. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

KEN SOCKWELL, ALLEN NOLES

ABSENT: NONE

Allen Noles, President of the Council, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Mayor David Bradford was also present. Richard Williams, City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Lockhart and seconded by Council Member Sockwell and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held regular meeting and work session of May 1, 2017 and approved the minutes as written.

Mayor Bradford read aloud a proclamation declaring May 7 - 13, 2017 as "Municipal Clerks Week" in the City. He also called on Chief Gilliland with the University of North Alabama. Chief Gilliland recognized Muscle Shoals Police Sgt. Marcus Johnson, Lt. Eric Balentine and Sgt. Jonathan Terry, all who successfully completed the Senior Officer Program conducted by the University. Mayor Bradford also noted that the city had received two Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grants. These grants will provide for an upgrade of the evidence management system (\$5,367.00) and upgrade light bearing holsters/gun mount weapon lights (\$5,500.00) in the police department.

President Noles announced that the next item of business was approval of a job description for Gas and Diesel Mechanic in the public works department.

Public Works Director Butch Fleming presented the job description and asked for City Council approval.

Council Member Sockwell moved that the job description be approved as presented. Council Member Hall seconded the motion and upon said motion being put to a vote all voted "AYE" and "NAYS" were none.

President Noles announced that the job description for Gas and Diesel Mechanic had been approved.

President Noles announced that the next item of business was consideration of a resolution to vacate a certain avenue and alleyways in Riverside Park Subdivision subject to an easement for a sewer line.

Council Member Hall introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption: STATE OF ALABAMA COLBERT COUNTY
