The Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the City Hall in said City at 6:20 p.m. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2011 being the regularly scheduled time and approved place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by David Bradford, Mayor of the City. The invocation was given by Rusty Wheeles. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

David Bradford, Mayor of the City, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Richard Williams, City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Holland seconded by Council Member Pampinto and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held regular meeting and work session of May 16, 2011 and the special called meeting of June 1, 2011 and approved the minutes as written.

Mayor Bradford announced that the next item of business was consideration of a resolution to authorize the Mayor to make application for FEMA Hazard Mitigation Funds.

Council Member Pampinto introduced the following resolution which was presented in the meeting and moved for its adoption:

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 2501 - 11

WHEREAS, Section 409 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief Act and Emergency Assistance Act(Public Law 92-228, as amended), Title 44 CFR, as amended by Section 102 of the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region IV, requires and provides a framework for all state and local governments to review and evaluate a local hazard mitigation strategy to protect life and property through an assessment of risk and mitigation practices, as a condition of receiving Federal disaster and hazard mitigation assistance, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muscle Shoals has satisfied all requirements to be eligible for hazard mitigation assistance, and

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation funds will be available as a result of the recent Disaster

Declaration FEMA-1971-DR-AL; now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama that the Mayor or the Mayor Pro-Tem, in the absence of the Mayor, be authorized to make application for these funds for the purchase and installation of emergency generators at the City Hall, Fire Station #2 and Public Works Facility, and an outdoor warning siren for the Shoals Research Airpark.

Council Member Grissom seconded the motion and upon said motion being put to a vote, all voted "AYE" and "NAYS" were none.

Mayor Bradford announced that the Resolution had been approved.
