MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD January 6, 2020

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:52 p.m. on the 6^{th} day of January, 2020 being the scheduled time and place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by Allen Noles, President of the Council. The invocation was given by Ricky Williams. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

PRESENT: CHRIS HALL, MIKE LOCKHART, KEN SOCKWELL, ALLEN NOLES ABSENT: NEAL WILLIS

Allen Noles, President of the Council, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Mayor David Bradford was also present. Ricky Williams, City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Lockhart and seconded by Council Member Hall and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held regular meeting and work session of December 30, 2019 and approved the minutes as written.

Mayor Bradford informed the Council that he had appointed Sammy Mayfield to the Planning and Zoning Board to a term expiring in December, 2024. He also offered condolences to the family of David Ryan upon his recent passing.

Council President Noles announced the next item of business was award of a bid for construction of sidewalks. 80% funding is provided by the Alabama Department of Transportation under project TAPAA-TA(909).

Council Member Hall introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. _____ AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, that the Zoning Ordinance and the Zoning Map of the City of Muscle Shoals, are hereby amended as follows:

That the following described area which are currently zoned B-2 and is hereby incorporated in and made a part of the R-2 District, to wit:

Portion of lot 29 Avalon Highlands #1; 303 W. State Street

The Council finds that legal notice of the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, was published by posting the same in four (4) conspicuous places in the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, 15 days prior to the date hereof, there

being no newspaper published in the City of Muscle Shoals, and said notice set for public hearing on the 6th day of January, 2020, at 6:00 o'clock p.m., in the Chambers of the Council of the City of Muscle Shoals located in the City Hall, Muscle Shoals, Alabama, for all persons to appear to be heard either for or against the adoption of said amendment; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held and President Noles announced that now was the proper time for persons in favor and those in opposition to the ordinance to be recognized.

John Hicks, the realtor for the property spoke concerning the financial burden of complying with laws enacted since the property was rezoned in 1977 such as the Americans with Disabilities Act. He noted that a local bank had refused financing as a residential property, its current use.

Janine Rogers, owner of the property, noted that she had lost three sales of the property as residential use since it is currently zoned business.

There being no one further wishing to speak, President Noles stated that approval of the ordinance was before the Council. All those in favor of the application would indicate so by voting aye and those opposed would indicate by voting nay. Upon said question being put to a vote, a roll call was had and the vote recorded as follows:

President Noles stated that the Council would hear from those persons in support of the issuance of the license as well as those opposed.

There being no one wishing to speak, President Noles stated that approval of the Lounge Retail Liquor License - Class II (Package) was before the Council.
