MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD December 16, 2019

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:30 p.m. on the 2nd day of December, 2019 being the scheduled time and place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by Allen Noles, President of the Council. The invocation was given by Ricky Williams. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

Allen Noles, President of the Council, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. WHEREAS, the City Council is informed by the various Department Heads that the City has no further use for said vehicles and equipment due to their age and condition and it is not economical for the City to retool or refit the said vehicles and equipment in order that it be able to be placed in service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the said vehicles and equipment are surplus property and the City has no further use for said vehicles and equipment due to their age and condition; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama that the following described vehicles and equipment be declared surplus property and be disposed of by the Procurement Officer of the city in a manner that will require no further expenditure by the City nor expose the City to any liability in the further use of or operation of said vehicles and equipment and the Council does hereby authorize the Procurement Officer to dispose of said vehicles and equipment by placement on Govdeals.com.
