MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD June 1, 2020

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:00 p.m. on the 1st day of June, 2020 being the scheduled time and place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by Allen Noles, Council President. The invocation was given by Ricky Williams. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

Allen Noles, Council President, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Mayor David Bradford was also present. Ricky Williams, City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Hall and seconded by Council Member McMinn and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held regular meeting and work session of May 19, 2020 and approved the minutes as written.

Mayor Bradford updated the Council on the City's COVID-19 efforts. He also noted that the Appalachian Regional Commission had approved a \$100,000 flood study for the southeast sector of the city. He informed the Council that a delegation from the area would be attending a meeting in Montgomery in support of the City's Industrial Access grant request to raise 6th Street near the Shoals Research Airpark. Mayor Bradford also noted that a funding request to the Economic Development Administration for \$2.6 million to install additional storm drainage from the Southgate Mall area was nearing final approval. He also shared that the Alabama Department of Transportation had approved a \$200,000 grant to assist in the expansion of the Wilson Dam retention pond.

Council President Noles announced the next item of business was consideration of a resolution to award a bid for the purchase of a connector boat.

Council Member McMinn introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

WHEREAS, the City did send out advertisements for bids for the purchase of a connector boat for the fire department, the bid opening being set for 10:00 am on the 29th day of May, 2020, at the City Hall of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, at the appointed time and place, as specified above, the following bids were opened and tabulated as follows; and

WHEREAS, NAFECO has submitted the lowest, responsive, responsible base bid of \$40,170.70, now

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the apparent lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, NAFECO is now awarded the bid for the purchase of a connector boat for a total bid price of \$40,170.70.

Council Member Sockwell seconded the motion and upon said motion being put to a vote, all voted "AYE" and "NAYS" were none.

Council President Noles announced that the resolution had been approved.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon the motion duly made and seconded the meeting was adjourned.
