MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD December 7, 2020

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:00 p.m. on the 7th day of December, 2020 being the scheduled time and place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by Ken Sockwell, Council President. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

PRESENT: CHRIS HALL, GINA CLARK, WILLIS THOMPSON,

KEN SOCKWELL, DAVID MOORE

ABSENT: NONE

Ken Sockwell, Council President, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Mayor Mike Lockhart was also present. Elaine Coan, Assistant City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

The invocation was given by Recreation Director Rusty Wheeles,. Mayor Mike Lockhart, led in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Moore and seconded by Council Member Thompson and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held organizational meeting and work session of November 16, 2020, and approved the minutes as written.

Mayor Mike Lockhart gave an overview of the 2021 proposed general fund budget.

President Sockwell announced that the next item of business was a public hearing to consider the adoption of an ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1530 - 20

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, that the Zoning Ordinance and the Zoning Map of the City of Muscle Shoals, are hereby amended as follows: That the following described area which are currently R-3 and is hereby incorporated in and made a part of the B-2 District, to wit:

East 40 ft of lot 4936 and lot 4937, Highland Park #12

The Council finds that legal notice of the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, was published by posting the same in four (4) conspicuous places in the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, 15 days prior to the date hereof, there being no newspaper published in the City of Muscle Shoals, and said notice set for public hearing on the 7th day of December, 2020 at 6:00 o'clock p.m., in the Chambers of the Council of the City of Muscle Shoals located in the City Hall, Muscle Shoals, Alabama, for all persons to appear to be heard either for or against the adoption of said amendment; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held and President Sockwell announced that now was the proper time for persons in favor and those in opposition to the ordinance to be recognized.

There being no one wishing to speak, President Sockwell stated that approval of the ordinance was before the Council. All those in favor of the application would indicate so by voting aye and those opposed would indicate by voting nay. Upon said question being put to a vote, a roll call was had and the vote recorded as follows:
