

**MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
COUNCIL OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA, HELD  
April 14, 2014**

---

The City Council of Muscle Shoals, Alabama met at the Muscle Shoals City Hall auditorium in said City at 6:05 p.m. on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014 being the scheduled time and approved place for said meeting. The meeting was called to order by James Holland, President of the Council. The invocation was given by Ricky Williams. On roll call the following members were found to be present or absent, as indicated:

James Holland, President of the Council, presided at the meeting and declared that a quorum was present and that the meeting was convened and opened for the purposes of transaction of business. Richard Williams, City Clerk, was present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Council Member Pampinto seconded by Council Member Lockhart and unanimously adopted, the Council waived the reading of the minutes of the previously held regular meeting and work session of March 17, 2014 and the April 3, 2014 special meeting and approved the minutes as written.

President Holland announced that the next item of business was to consider an ordinance to amend section 14-24 of the City Code prohibiting a dog from being tied, chained or tethered.

Council Member Lockhart introduced the following ordinance and moved that the rules be suspended for immediate consideration:

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1460 - 14  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-24 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE CITY OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama that Section 14-24 of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, same being authorized by and contained in Ordinance 1418-09 and approved and adopted by the City Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama on October 5, 2009 is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

Section 14-24- Tethering.

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to tie, chain or tether such dog.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance, and its provisions, shall become effective upon publication or posting pursuant to law or as otherwise provided for by law.

Council Member Noles seconded the motion and upon said question being put to a vote, a roll call was had and the vote recorded as follows:
