This year's Muscle Shoals Public Library summer reading program was entitled "One Hundred Years of Stories" in honor of the city's centennial. The children and teens were challenged to read a minimum number of books to finish the program, but they were encouraged to keep reading all summer. Kids who read 100 books were awarded a medal by Fire Chief Shawn Malone on July 28, and Sparky also made a special appearance. Program participants read and logged over 11,000 books from June 1 through July 28, with 248 children and teens actively participating. Around sixty kids reached the 100 books goal, with many of them reading well over 100 books each. Other summer library fun included wild animal and bird shows, a visit by authors Irene Latham and Charles Waters, nine story times (including one special one with Santa!), two STEM hang-outs, 4-H robotics camp, a W. C. Handy concert with Microwave Dave and audience participation, and three kids' book clubs. It has been an awesome summer of reading and fun at MSPL!


