INMATE RULES & PROHIBITED ACTS

While in this facility you must at all times conduct yourself in a well-behaved manner.

Breaches of policy may result in you being disciplined, reclassified, being charged with criminal offenses, or any combination of the two.

Prohibited acts:

- 1. Abusive, derogatory, demeaning, or inappropriate speech
- 2. Being in an unauthorized area
- 3. Being in the area of, having control over, or possession of contraband
- 4. Being unsanitary or untidy
- 5. Blocking a viewing device, i.e., windows, monitors, mirror, doors
- 6. Blocking an officer's view with a device or body movement
- 7. Blocking or obstructing the pathway of another
- 8. Blocking or tampering with vent duct
- 9. Conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline
- 10. Counterfeiting, forging, or unauthorized reproduction
- 11. Creating a disturbance
- 12. Destroying, altering, or damaging facility property or property of another
- 13. Disrespect toward a staff member
- 14. Disruptive conduct or interfering with security
- 15. Encouraging others to refuse to work
- 16. Encouraging, facilitating, or conspiring with others
- 17. Extortion or intimidation
- 18. Failing to keep person or quarters in high standards
- 19. Failing to move aside for an officer, employee, or visitor
- 20. Failing to perform work as instructed by a staff member
- 21. Failing to return as scheduled
- 22. Failure to follow safety or sanitation regulations
- 23. Failure to maintain personal hygiene or clean uniform/clothing
- 24. Fighting, assaulting, or arguing with another
- 25. Gambling
- 26. Giving or offering staff members a bribe or anything of value
- 27. Harassment of any type directed toward any staff member, employee, contractor, or other inmate
- 28. Hording of food, personal supplies, or other items
- 29. Interfering with a communications, such as a telephone, speaker
- 30. Leaving the facility without authorization
- 31. Loaning of property or anything of value for profit or increased return
- 32. Lying or providing a false statement to a staff member
- 33. Making, possessing, or using intoxicants
- 34. Malingering or feigning an illness
- 35. Misuse of authorized medication
- 36. Operating a business in the jail
- 37. Participating in an unauthorized meeting or gathering
- 38. Possession of contraband
- 39. Possession of property belonging to another person or government
- 40. Possession of legal papers, documents, or evidence of another
- 41. Refusing to promptly obey an order
- 42. Starting a fire or burning an object

- 43. Stealing [theft]
- 44. Tampering or obstructing a security device
- 45. Interfering with a life safety device
- 46. Tampering with or obstructing a locking device
- 47. Threatening behavior
- 48. Touching, striking, or interfering with an employee
- 49. Unexcused absence from work or any assignment
- 50. Using abusive language
- 51. Violating a condition of temporary release
- 52. Violation of any municipal, county, state, or federal law
- 53. Violation of any other facility rule

Contraband:

Contraband is any item that was not issued, or determined as allowable. Contraband includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Alcohol
- 2. Cell phone, or parts of a cell phone
- 3. Chemicals, either commercial or homemade
- 4. Club
- 5. Excess supplies or items
- 6. Eating or using mess utensils other than during meal time(s)
- 7. Food or consumable items not supplied by the facility
- 8. Firearm or ammunition
- 9. Glass
- 10. Knife, pointed, or sharp edged item
- 11. Legal pagers belonging to another inmate
- 12. Matches or fire making material
- 13. Metal cans
- 14. Hard plastic, nylon,, or similar synthetic material
- 15. Mind altering substances
- 16. Money or financial instrument
- 17. Prescription or non-prescription medicines or drugs
- 18. Projectile or missile
- 19. Property of another
- 20. Tobacco or tobacco products
